



BAY LAKE CAMPGROUND POLICIES (User guidelines)

MAXIMUM EQUIPMENT PER SITE:

RV/Camp site: 1 Trailer/RV, 1 Vehicle, 1 Dining tent/gazebo, 4 adults max.
Tent site: 2 Tents, 6 people max.

MAXIMUM LENGTH OF STAY: The maximum length of stay is 21 days.

RESERVATIONS: Reservations can be made by calling the Town Office during regular business hours. A cheque or money order must be sent in advance to reserve booking. Reservations will be held until 2:00 p.m. on the day of the booking.

CANCELLATIONS: At least 24 hours notice is required to cancel a reservation. Payment will not be deposited until arrival.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES: Visitors are asked to check-in by 2:00 p.m. and check-out by 12:00 p.m.

DAY VISITORS: Day visitors are allowed from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. free of charge; maximum 4 per site. If a day visitor decides to spend the night there will be a \$5.00 per night fee.

FACILITIES

- Modern comfort station with flush toilets and hot showers
- Septic dumping station, ice and propane available at local gas station
- Clean sandy beach; covered pavilion with picnic tables
- Kid's playground & baseball diamond
- Boardwalk, docks & boat launch
- ATV, biking, and hiking trails

PETS: Visitors are asked to keep all pets on a leash no longer than 2 metres (6 ft). Pet droppings must be cleaned up by pet's owner. Loud or vicious pets will not be tolerated

QUIET HOURS: Quiet hours are between 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. Loud parties and profane language will not be tolerated Town will post when dances are being held at the Recreation Centre

FIRES: Fires are allowed in established fire rings. Burning garbage is not permitted. Fires must not be left unattended.

FIREWOOD: The local gas station sells bundles of firewood.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING: Deposit garbage and recycling in provided containers at the campground. Make full use of both trash and recycling receptacles.

SWIMMING: The beach area is unsupervised. No lifeguards are on duty and swimming is at your own risk. The Town encourages a responsible adult to monitor all children activities near the beach area.

OFF ROAD VEHICLE USE: Users can park their off road vehicle (e.g. ATV) on their site if desired. You must however not drive around the campground. The Town encourages users to take the shortest path from their campsite to the main road.

FIREARMS: Rifles, BB, pellet, paint ball guns, bow and arrows, sling shots, and other weapons are not permitted in the campground. All firearms must be locked and stored in a locked vehicle or personal trailer.

ALCOHOL: Drinking in public is not permitted. Alcohol is limited to your campsite.

TELEPHONE: A pay phone is located at the Comfort Station and the Town Office.

WASTE WATER / GREY WATER COLLECTION: All waste water/grey water must be collected in a container.
