

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF COUNCIL HELD ON SEPT 14TH 2000.

Present: Mayor Lefebvre and all councillors with the exception of Councillor Joe Symons and Councillor Nicole Paige.

1. Moved by Councillor Anne Chaput, Seconded by Councillor Beth Inglis:

That the minutes of the meeting as held on the 10th and 15th day of August be adopted as read and distributed by the Clerk.

2. Moved by Councillor Beth Inglis, Seconded by Councillor Wayne Humphries:

That Council for the Corporation of the Town of Latchford enter into a contract with the Municipal Service Providers for the provision of Animal Control in Latchford on presentation and approval of the required contract.

3. Moved by Councillor Anne Chaput, Seconded by Councillor Diane Remillard:

WHEREAS the increase in the frequency testing for "Pesticides and PCB's" (from once every ten years to quarterly) as well as "Volatile Organics" (once every five years to four times per year) have been imposed upon all Municipalities, regardless of location

AND WHEREAS these contaminants are more related to industrial wastes which are predominant in more industrialized areas,

AND WHEREAS Council feels that these tests are expensive and unnecessary in most areas of Northern Ontario,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this Council petition the Honourable Dan Newman to reconsider the imposition of an increased frequency of this sort of unnecessary testing in areas that are not subject to this variety of contamination.

That By-Law No. 575/00 being a by-law to provide for advance votes to be held prior to voting day, having been given it's first, second and final reading be now passed in open Council.
