WHEREAS Canada Post and the Conservatives are taking an axe to long-treasured postal services – killing good jobs, eliminating door-to-door delivery, drastically increasing postage rates and closing, downsizing and reducing hours at post offices:

WHEREAS Canada Post did not properly consult on these changes, effectively eliminating any opportunity for input from the people who will be most affected; and

- Maintain the current operations and create a more formal agreement between the supporting municipalities for the MSB with ownership of the assets remaining with the Township of Armstrong; and

Whereas the MSB has requested that each Council pass a motion indicating its preferred option for f further investigation.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Corporation of the Town Of Latchford hereby endorses Option A / Option B for further investigation by the Earlton-Timiskaming Regional Airport Joint Municipal Services Board and that a copy of their findings be presented back to the member municipalities of the MSB at the conclusion of their investigation.

1. Hydro One Debt retirement charge

Whereas the Corporation of the Town of Latchford sold the Latchford Hydro Electric Corporation (LHEC) to Hydro One in October, 2000,

And whereas the LHEC was without debt at the time of sale to Hydro One,

And whereas the former customers of the LHEC are compelled to pay a debt retirement charge on their hydro bills to pay off an alleged debt that was incurred by the former Ontario Hydro prior to the year 2000 when they were not customers of that utility,

And whereas the Council for the Corporation of the Town of Latchford consider that to bill all users in Latchford for a debt that was not incurred by them, or for them, is improper and tantamount to fraud, Therefore be it resolved that the Council for the Corporation of the Town of Latchford do hereby request the Ombudsman for Ontario to examine the legitimacy of billing the debt retirement charge for the former Ontario Hydro to our residences that were served by the LHEC at the time these debts were incurred and advise as to how they can recover the amount they have already paid to Hydro One.

And further, that this resolution be forwarded to the Councils of Virginia town and Larder Lake whose residents are equally impacted by the incorrect billing of a debt retirement charge by Hydro One as both those municipalities owned their own hydro electric corporations prior to 2000.
