AND WHEREAS in many small and rural municipalities it will make it more difficult for people with disabilities to fully participate and discourage qualified candidates;

AND WHEREAS the Province has stated that they want to encourage more local decision making;

AND WHEREAS the voters list will not be ready until after this date;

AND WHEREAS the choice of ranked ballot was left to the municipalities to decide;

AND WHEREAS the verification of these forms will place an additional burden on already strained resources in small municipalities;

AND WHEREAS the benefit of such a requirement should be left to the municipalities to determine;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town Of Latchford request the Province to re-evaluate this requirement and allow it to be an optional local decision to avoid negative consequences to many municipalities.

FURTHER THAT this resolution be circulated to the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Critics for Municipal Affairs, the Association of Municipalities of Ontario, and the Federation of Northern Ontario Municipalities for consideration.
