

Dear Latchford resident,

We are pleased to provide you with an exceptional recycling program. For anyone who is unsure of what is recyclable in the program, please keep this information sheet for future reference.

Collection will be provided every Monday, with the exception of Holiday Mondays, in which case collection will commence on that Tuesday. Please remember to rinse your recyclables of food residue and shred any paper which may contain your private information, as your recyclables may pass through many hands after Eco-Logix has collected it.

RECYCLABLE MATERIAL

The material to be collected will include the following:

a) Mixed Paper	includes newspaper, inserts, junk mail, magazines, catalogues, phone books, writing and computer paper, glossy flyers, egg cartons, coloured paper, clean packaging paper and paperback books ***
b) Boxboard:	cereal boxes, cardboard tubes and similar material flattened
c) Corrugated Cardboard:	(has a wavy corrugation in middle) Must be flattened and tied in bundles not larger than 75 cm x 120 cm and up to 25 cm thick (30" x 48" x 10") when collected by the recycling collection vehicle. It includes brown paper and clean pizza boxes.
e) Aluminium/ metal Cans	includes beverage and food cans
f) Glass, clear & coloured:	beverage bottles and jars only
g) Plastics	plastic containers designated with recycling symbol and #1 or #2.

Please do not put any of the following items in your recycling bin: Food, diapers, milk cartons, plastic bags, dishes, chemicals, used tissue, unrinsed/dirty materials, Etc.



Accepted Recycling Practices

What can I put in my blue bin?

- Empty plastics that contain the recycling symbol on them (water bottles and laundry soap containers)
- Empty steel and aluminum cans used for food and drink (soup cans and soda cans)
- Empty paper products (newspaper and cereal boxes etc.)
- Empty glass jars (spaghetti jars and drink containers etc.)
- Broken down cardboard boxes
- Electronics (cell phones, tvs, radios, batteries)

General rules

- *All cardboard must be broken down flat for recycling. Very large amounts should be bundled together.
- *Cardboard boxes cannot be used as recycling bins for mixed recycling, however a box can be used to contain other broken down cardboard boxes.
- *Black bags are not accepted for containing recycling. Clear bags are accepted.
- *No food waste
- *No medical waste
- *No wood or metal scraps
- *No cigarette butts
- *No human or animal waste
- *No large heavy carts for loose recycling (we must be able to safely lift and tip and recycling container) but you can use the larger carts to hold your clear bags.
- *No Kleenex, toilette paper, paper towels, pads or tampons
- *No clothes, fabrics, shoes etc.
- *No pots, pans, dishes, vases etc.
- *Collectors will not be verbally or physically abused or bullied. This will result in discontinued collection services to your residence or business.
- *Inappropriate materials will be left behind
- *Please have your bins out by 8:30 am

Exceptions

Materials accepted in this program:

Plastics:

- 1 PETE-Water bottle, soft drink bottles, juice bottles, mouthwash bottles, peanut butter containers, salad dressing bottles, etc.
- 2 HDPE-Milk jugs, Juices bottles, Cosmetics, shampoo, detergent, household cleaners, motor oil bottles, etc.
- 3 PVC-Food trays, cling film, cooking oil bottles, water jugs, Etc.
- 4 LDPE- Squeezable bottles etc. 6 pack rings, container lids, etc.
- 5 PP-Yogert containers, syrup bottles, ketchup bottles, margarine tubs, straws, microwavable meal trays, medicine bottles, etc.
- 6 PS- Meal trays, egg cartons, disposable plates and cups, takeout food containers, coat hangers, clear trays, protective packing, meat trays, compact disc cases, three and five gallon pails, etc.
- 7 OTHER-Three and five gallon water bottles, DVD cases, certain food containers.
- Misc.- Clear plastic bags, shrink wrap, bubble wrap

Cardboard:

Broken down

Paper board:

Cereal, cake mix, pizza, shoe, shirt and cracker boxes, beer and pop cases, paper coffee cups, etc.

Metals:

Steel and aluminum cans

Glass:

Clear and colored glass bottles and jars used for food and drink

All-in-one computers, Answering machines, Audio cassette players/recorders, Camera dock printers, Cameras (Digital and non-digital), CD players/recorders, CD-ROM drives, Cellular phones, Closed circuit monitors, Closed circuit television screens, Computer keyboards, Computer mouse, Computer terminals, Cordless Telephone, Desktop all in one devices, Desktop computers, Desktop Copiers, Desktop printers, Digital picture frames, Dual computer monitors, Dual television, DVD drives, External hard drive, Fax machines, Floor standing copiers, Floor standing multifunction ,Floor standing printers ,Floppy-disk drives ,Handheld personal computers, Handheld printers, HD-DVD drives, Home radios, Home Theatre Equipment, Laptops, Mini notebooks, Modems (wired and wireless), Monitors, Netbooks, Notebooks, Notepads, Pagers, Palmtop, PDA (cell enabled), Portable audio/video players, Portable DVD players, Portable MP3/Digital audio players, Portable PC-free photo printers, Portable radios, Portable speakers, Professional Displays, Projectors (video, audio, image), Scanners Smart Phones, Stereo amplifiers, Stereo speakers, Stereo turn tables, Tablet PCs, Telephone (Rotary), Telephone (wired), Televisions, Thin clients, Typewriters (electric), Vehicle DVD/Blu-ray players, Vehicle radios, audio players, speakers, Video cameras (analog and digital), Video player/recorder(DVD/VCR/Blu-ray), Webcams, Etc.

Other:

Household and motor vehicle batteries, ink and toner cartridges, packaging styrofoam

Recyclable Materials Include:

- PAPER PRODUCTS newspapers, magazines, computer paper, pamphlets, flyers, envelopes, writing paper, cardboard, boxboard, cereal boxes, old corrugated cardboard, tissue boxes, soup boxes and shoe boxes, etc.
- ALUMINUM /STEEL CANS used for food and drink
- GLASS JARS AND BOTTLES used for food and drink
- PLASTIC CONTAINERS plastic containers labeled with #1-7
- Electronics (has to be light enough for one man to carry)
- Ink & Toner cartridges
- Batteries
- Styrofoam used for packaging/shipping
- Milk and juice cartons
- Tetra-paks (juice box type materials)
- Aerosol cans
- Empty paint cans
- Aluminum foil and plates

NON-Recyclable Materials Include:

- PAPER such as wax paper, paper towels, waxed grocery boxes
- METAL coat hangers, metal pots and pans
- GLASS such as drinking glasses, cups, dishes, window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, pottery, glass pots and pans, make up jars
- PLASTIC all plastic material which does not have the #1-7 recycling symbols.
