THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LATCHFORD BY-LAW NO. 2021-023

BEING A BY-LAW TO RECOGNIZE AN AMENDMENT TO THE PURPOSE OF THE TEMISKAMING MUNICIPAL SERVICES ASSOCIATION ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Latchford entered into an agreement with Temiskaming Municipal Services Association dated for the provision of enforcement of the *Building Code Act*, 1992, SO 1992, c 23, chief building official services, and building inspector services;

AND WHEREAS the Temiskaming Municipal Services Association has voted in favor of a fundamental change pursuant to Section 197(1)(i) of the *Canada Not-for-Profit Corporations Act*;

AND WHEREAS the special resolution to amend the purpose has passed with a 2/3 majority of the members;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LATCHFORD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the Council of the Town of Latchford recognize the amendment to the Temiskaming Municipal Services Association purpose to read as follows:
- (a) for the management and administration of building construction permitting and inspections for member municipalities;
- (b) managing and administering a system, service or thing for member municipalities as is permitted by the Municipal Act of Ontario and agreed to by the members;
- (c) to enter into fee for service agreement with such other municipalities who do not wish to be members but wish to receive some/all of the services listed above; and
- (d) such other purposes not inconsistent with the above.
- **2.** THAT the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby consented, as evidenced by their respective signatures hereto.
- **3.** THAT the Temiskaming Municipal Services Association be appointed to perform the functions specified in said agreement and Articles of Incorporation.
- **4.** THAT all by-laws and resolutions, or parts thereof, contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
