## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LATCHFORD BY-LAW NO. 2022-021

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO.2020-015 A BYLAW TO APPOINT A MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENFORCING MUNICIPAL BY-LAWS

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 15 (1) of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, Council of a municipality may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 15 (2) of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, defines municipal law enforcement officers as peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal bylaws;

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Offences Act R.S.O 1990, c. P 33 provides for the designation by a Minister of the Crown of any person or class of persons as a Provincial Offences Officer for the purposes of all or any class of offence;

**AND WHEREAS** by Orders dated July 30, 1984 and August 21, 1987, the Solicitor General has designated all employees whose duties include the enforcement of municipal by-laws and persons appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers under the Police Services Act as Provincial Offences Officers;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Latchford Passed By-Law No. 2020-015 to appoint Pete Gilboe as the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the purpose of enforcing the by-laws of the Town of Latchford;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Latchford enacts the following:

- 1. That By-law Number 2020-015 is hereby amended to recognize Peter Gilboe as By-law/ Property Standards Enforcement Officer.
- 2. That this By-law shall take effect upon final passing thereof.
